# 11 Ideas for Honoring Service Members and Veterans

# 1. Participate in a Wreath-Laying Ceremony and Honor Flights

Join or sponsor a wreath-laying ceremony at a veterans' cemetery through programs like Wreaths Across America. Additionally, volunteer with Honor Flight to help accompany veterans on free trips to Washington, D.C. to visit memorials built in their honor.

# 2. Visit a Veterans Home or Hospital

Spend time with veterans at a local VA hospital or state veterans' home. A simple conversation or game of cards can mean a lot. Find facilities using the VA Facility Locator and your state's Department of Veterans Affairs.

## 3. Send a Handwritten Letter or Make Paracord Bracelets

Brighten a service member's or veteran's day with a heartfelt letter or bracelet through Operation Gratitude or Soldiers' Angels.

#### 4. Donate Toiletries to Veterans' Shelters

Small bottles of soap, shampoo, toothpaste, and other essentials are always appreciated. Find shelters through the National Coalition for Homeless Veterans.

# 5. Send Care Packages

Organizations like Support Our Troops, Blue Star Moms, and USO Wishbook help assemble and send care packages to deployed troops.

#### 6. Make Holiday Stockings for Heroes

Spread cheer by creating stockings for service members and veterans with Soldiers' Angels.

#### 7. Provide Transportation Services

Help veterans get to and from medical or mental health appointments. Learn how to volunteer at Volunteer VA.

### 8. Donate Books

Send gently used books to active-duty military members and veterans through **Operation Paperback.** 

#### 9. Foster a Military Service Member's Pet or Raise a Service Dog In Training

Volunteer to foster a pet for a deployed service member through PACT for Animals or Dogs on Deployment. Alternatively, help raise a puppy that will one day become a service dog for a veteran through an Assistance Dogs International accredited organization.

#### 10. Assist with Airline and Hotel Travel

Support military members by donating airline miles or hotel points through Fisher House and Mercy Medical Angels.

# 11. Wear Red on Fridays

Show solidarity for deployed service members by wearing red on Fridays—also known as **RED Friday** (Remember Everyone Deployed).
